The Music Society is this year again arranging a visit to one of the Henry Wood Promenade Concerts at the Royal Albert Hall, London. The details are:

Date: Sunday, 11 August, 2019 at 8.00pm (Please note that this is half an hour later than we have become used to on past occasions. The concert is scheduled to end at c.10.05 pm.)

Cost: £42 per person (all seats are in the Side Stalls), (£21 for under-19s, thanks to a subsidy from the Witney Educational Foundation)
