PROMENADE CONCERT AT THE ROYAL ALBERT HALL 2022

The Music Society is this year again arranging a visit to one of the Henry Wood Promenade Concerts at the Royal Albert Hall, London, as follows:

Date	Thursday 25 August 2022 at 7.30pm
Performers	BBC Symphony Orchestra Conductor – Fabien Gabel Violin – Daniel Lozakovich
Programme	Lalo: <i>Le Roi d'Ys</i> – overture [11 min] Brahms: Violin concerto in D major [38 min] INTERVAL Franck: Symphony in D minor [37 min]

French composers Lalo and Franck were 19th-century contemporaries. The stirring overture to Lalo's Breton opera *Le roi d'Ys* is not unlike the music of Berlioz. Franck's *Symphony in D minor* has the rich sonorities found in his organ music. Swedish violinist Daniel Lozakovich is a major new talent making his Proms debut in one of the great Romantic violin concertos.

Cost: £50 per person (all seats are in the Stalls)

(£25 for under-19s, thanks to a subsidy from Witney Educational Foundation)

The cost covers the price of the seat ticket and the coach journey plus the driver's gratuity.

The tickets will be issued on the outward coach journey **but payment for the trip needs to be made at the time of booking**. Confirmation of your place and receipt of your payment will be acknowledged either by e-mail or by post.
